1. Contents of E-Poster & Oral

The contents of the Oral and E-poster presentation should have the following sections.

Research Papers

- Introduction/Background
- Rationale of the study & Objectives
- Materials & Methodology
- Results & Discussion
- Summary & Conclusion
- References & Acknowledgment

Literature Review / Student Review Papers

- Introduction/Background
- Rationale of the study & Objectives
- Methodology
- Results & Discussion
- Summary & Conclusion
- References & Acknowledgment

E-Poster Presentation – Instructions

- The specified **E-Poster template** should be followed in the preparation and presentation of all E-Posters.
- The **E-Poster ID** should appear on the poster.
- Poster should be written **ONLY in English language**.
- The **title of the E-Poster should be the same as submitted in the abstract**.
- **Images, graphs and tables should be well organized with high resolution**.
- The poster presenter will have **5 minutes** for E-Poster presentation.
- The participants are required to adhere to the timings and maintain conference decorum.
- **4 minutes** - Presentation
- **1 minutes** - Q&A

Oral Presentation - Instructions

- **Online presentation are not allowed**.
- **Computers and projector will be provided by the host**.
- Presentation should be prepared in **MS PowerPoint**.
- Maximum **10 slides** are allowed.
- **Avoid using light colours in figures**.
- Use a **clean background** and **avoid unnecessary animations**.
- Total time allotted for oral presentation: **10 minutes**
 - **8 minutes** - Presentation
 - **2 minutes** - Q&A
