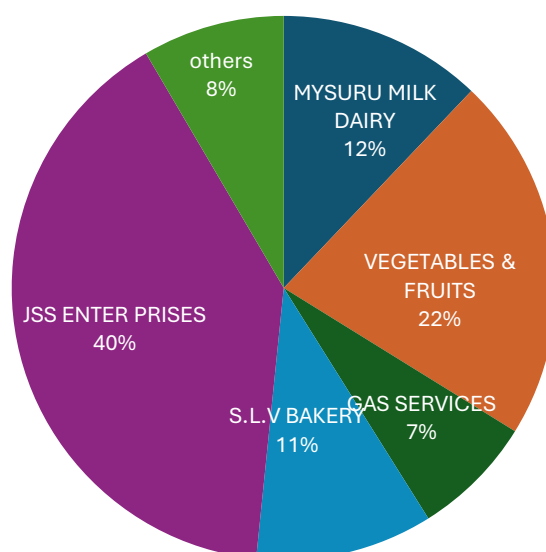


**Distribution Pattern of Food and related products purchase at JSSAHER.**
