

Anti-Corruption and Anti-Bribery Policy of JSS Academy of Higher Education & Research

Preamble:

JSS Academy of Higher Education & Research (JSS AHER) is committed to upholding the highest standards of integrity, transparency, and ethical conduct. This Anti-Corruption and Anti-Bribery Policy outlines our dedication to preventing corruption and bribery in all aspects of our university's operations and interactions.

Policy Statement:
