

Student Society Policy of JSS Academy of Higher Education & Research

Preamble:

JSS Academy of Higher Education & Research (JSS AHER) recognizes the importance of extracurricular activities and student engagement in promoting a holistic educational experience. The Student Society Policy outlines the guidelines and procedures for the formation, recognition, and operation of student societies within the university.

Policy Statement:

JSS AHER encourages the establishment of student societies to provide opportunities for students to pursue their interests, passions, and talents beyond academics. These societies play a vital role in fostering leadership skills, teamwork, and a sense of belonging among students.

Objectives:
