JSS AHER Senior Research Fellowship (JSS AHER - SRF)

1. PREAMBLE

JSS-AHER is providing a opportunity for full time research scholars of the university with JSS AHER-Senior Research Fellowship (SRF) for fostering a supportive and conducive research ecosystem for attracting top talent research scholars, promoting diversity with inclusiveness, and ultimately advancing the knowledge and innovations in the field of health sciences.

In continuation with Junior Research Fellowship, this helps in grooming young and bright minds of Ph.D. scholars to achieve excellence and contribute to organizations and medical fields. The scheme is designed to upgrade the qualitative outcomes of Research & Innovation through innovation. JSS AHER-SRF provides one-year (12 months) financial support for deserved candidates having essential requirements that enables to upgrade new skills, technologies, collaborating with leading JSS research groups, broaden one's horizon, offers a platform to work full-time and bringing them in a level of experience & maturity in the campus premises. The eligible fellows for the award of Rs. 20,000/- per month for the entire tenure of fellowship.

2. NUMBER OF FELLOWSHIPS

Initially 50 numbers of fellowships per year will be sanctioned in the 3rd year (for a period of One (01) year) to eligible candidates.

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR JSS AHER SENIOR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP

- i. Only full-time registered Ph.D. students (non-stipendiary) are eligible for fellowships.
- ii. Completed 2 years of Ph.D. Program under JSS AHER, Mysuru.
- iii. Qualified GATE/ NET in respective fields will be preferred.
- iv. The Ph.D. students who are already receiving fellowships/ scholarship/ stipend/ salary from other funding agency/ sources are not eligible for fellowship.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- i. Scholars have submitted all four-half yearly progress reports on time.
- ii. This fellowship will not be applicable during the extension period of their Ph.D.
- iii. Should have published papers in journals indexed in Scopus /Web of Science during the period of their enrollment for Ph.D.
- iv. Presented research work in National/International conferences during period of

enrollment of Ph.D.

- v. Weightage would be given to patents and awards received at the conference presentations.
- vi. He / She should be pursuing his research work in the laboratories in our campuses.
- vii. He may have to undertake teaching/lab assignment that may be given by the guide from time to time.
- viii. Fellowship will not be paid if the student is absent beyond the eligible days of absence.

5. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications for JSS AHER SRF will be invited every year, the potential candidates are required to fill the application form and the same need to be forwarded through the Guide/Supervisor and Head of the Department/Institution to the **Registrar**, **JSS AHER**, **Mysuru**.

6. AGE LIMIT

The upper age limit for applying for the award of SRF shall be 45 years.

7. SELECTION PROCEDURE

Potential candidates fulfilling the evaluation criteria and obtaining a minimum of **50** marks will be awarded for JSS AHER SRF for a period of One-year. Assessing the academic records, published research work/ project work the selection will be made. JSS AHER reserves the right for selection decision and binding on the candidate.

8. DELIVERABLES

The candidate should be abiding by the deliverables to the achieved during the tenure and the same will be decided by Supervisor. If the deliverables are not achieved, the fellowship could be discontinued.

9. TENURE

The validity of the award letter shall be during 3rd year of Ph.D. work for period of 12 months (One-year) from the date mentioned in the award letter. The fellowship shall stand terminated from the date of Ph.D. viva-voce or from the date the fellow resigns his/her resignation has been accepted by JSS AHER or on completion of tenure whichever is earlier. If the candidate discontinues the Ph.D. program, he/she shall need to return the fellowship amount received from JSS AHER. The candidate can avail the fellowship only once.

10. FELLOWSHIP AMOUNT

JSS AHER SRF is entitled to an amount of Rs. 20,000/- per month for the entire tenure of the fellowship. HRA is not included. Monthly fellowship will be dispersed on receipt of duly signed bills, attendance records, and progress report by the Supervisor and Head of the Department and forwarded by Head of the Institution.

11. PROGRESS REPORT

The monthly progress report is an essential part of the fellow's work and the same shall be submitted in the prescribed proforma and duly signed by Supervisor and Head of the Department/ Institute along with claim forms. The results should be presented quantitatively in tables/ figures and discussed in terms of the objectives, and methodology. Copies of papers published/ communicated; patent/ copyrights filled/ published/ granted should also be submitted. Attendance record must accompany the monthly report.

11. PUBLICATIONS

Research outcomes of the fellow's work should be published in high reputed journals of Scopus, PubMed, Web of Science indexed journals only and ensure that the financial assistance provided by JSS AHER should always be acknowledged in all such publications along with SRF award letter number. One copy of the same should be submitted along with the annual progress report.

12. OBLIGATIONS OF RESEARCH FELLOW

The research fellow must carry out full-time research at JSS AHER and regular attendance may be ensured through an attendance register by the same department. The Research Fellow may assist the host department/ institute in its academic/ research related work/ activities provided such assignments should not hamper the progress of research work of the fellow. The fellow is **NOT** allowed to receive any other fellowship while availing the JSS AHER SRF without the prior approval of authorities. No fellow shall discontinue his/her fellowship without prior approval of JSS AHER. The research fellow must submit a detailed consolidated report of the research work carried out during the entire period of fellowship on completion of the tenure/submission of thesis/resignation from the fellowship through the research supervisor and head of the department within one month.

13. LEAVE

Leave can be obtained as per the JSS AHER leave policy for research scholar's guidelines during the tenure period.

14. TRANSFER OF FELLOWSHIP

Request for transfer of fellowship within constituent college/ Department of JSS AHER will not be entertained except on compelling circumstances for which the fellow and his/ her guide should submit proper justification. The No Objection Certificate should be produced by the fellow from supervisor and Head of Department of constituent colleges/ University Departments from where transfer is sought and consent of the Guide/Head of other constituent colleges/ University Departments to be transferred by giving reasons of transfer. **Prior approval from the authorities of JSS AHER** should be sought before transfer of fellowship.
