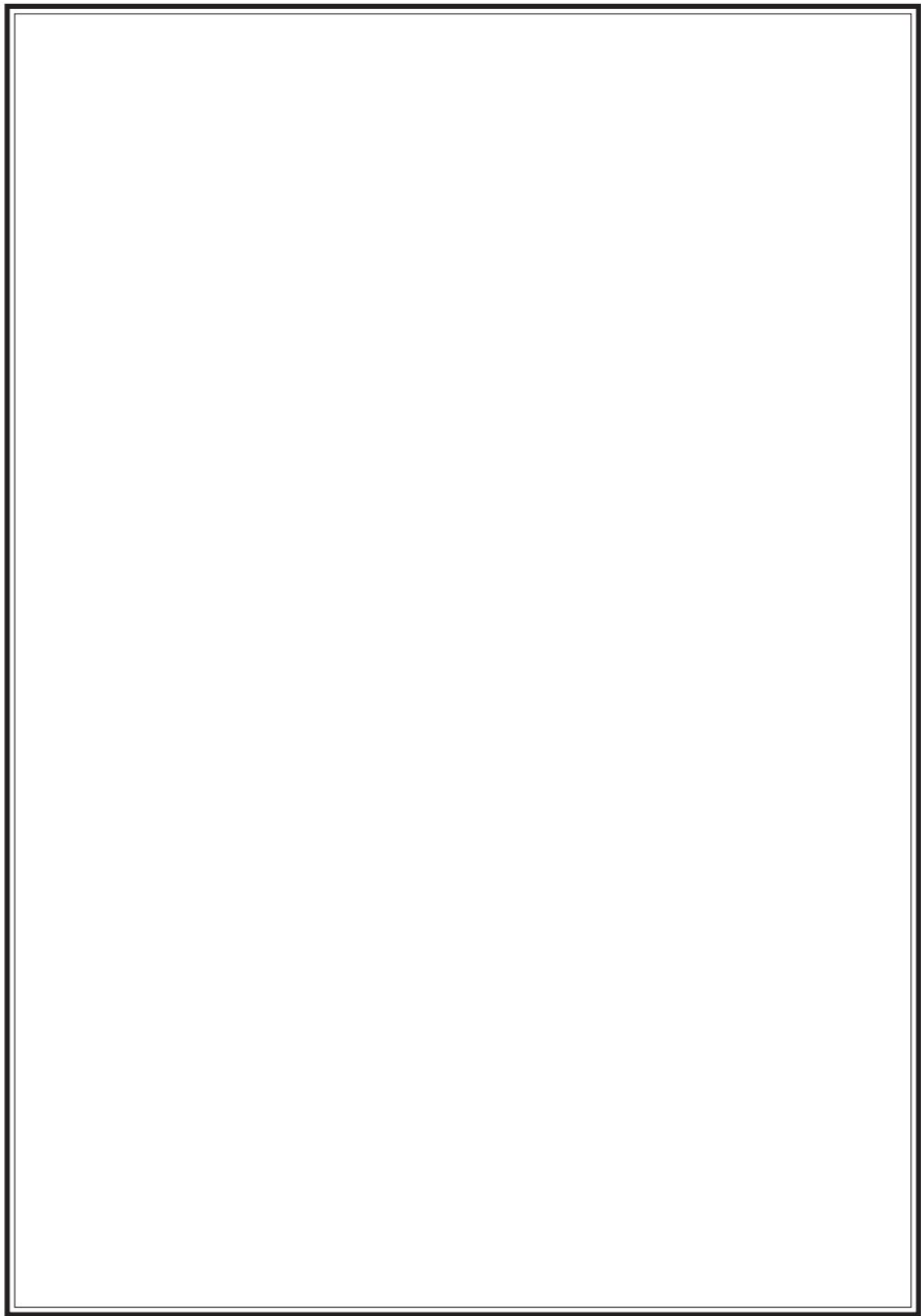

Discipline and punctuality are the two basic requirements to become a good technologist. The students should be regular and punctual for the academic program.



### **DRESS CODE**

**GIRLS:** Should be dressed in Chudidars or Sarees only, with hair combed neatly. (Scarf if any to be worn inside the apron).

**BOYS :** Should be dressed in shirts, trousers and leather shoes , well-groomed with short hair.

**INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS:** Should also dress formally and to be acceptable regionally.

### **Anti-Ragging Rule**

Ragging is prohibited as per the decision of the supreme court of India in write petition no. (c) 656/1998. If an incidence of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the accused student will be given an opportunity to explain and if the explanation is not satisfactory the authority will initiate suitable action against the accused student. Sexual harassment is strictly prohibited as per UGC guidelines & is punishable under various provisions of IPC.

### **DURATION OF THE COURSE:**

Duration shall be for a period of three years followed by one year internship for semester scheme. Except for BSc.(Hons) Genetics and Genomics which shall be for a period of four years and BOT which is of four year period with sixmonths internship.

**MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:** The medium of instruction and examination shall be in English

### **ATTENDANCE:**

Candidates should have attended at least **75%** of the total number of classes conducted in an academic year, from the date of commencement of the term to the last working day, as notified by the University, in each of the subjects prescribed for that year, separately in theory and practical, to be eligible to appear for the University examinations. Candidates lacking in prescribed percentage of attendance in any subject, either in theory or practical, in the first appearance, will not be eligible to appear for the University examination in that subject, unless they put in the required attendance, to appear in the subsequent examinations.



### **Internal Assessment Examination**

There shall be a minimum of two Internal assessment examinations in theory and practical's spread over evenly in each semester. The average marks of two IA examinations shall be submitted to the University at least 15 days before the commencement of the University examination. The University shall have access to the records of IA examinations. Candidates have to secure **35%** marks in the IA theory and practical jointly in each subject to become eligible to appear for the University examination.

The marks of the IA examinations will be displayed on the notice board of the respective departments within a fortnight from the date of IA examination.

Improvement Internal assessment shall be conducted for repeaters for the next university examinations.

### **Examination Guidelines**

**Eligibility criteria:** Attendance 75% of total number of classes

Internal Assessment: Minimum 35% of marks aggregate from two internals for all semester students.

### **During Theory Examinations**

While writing theory examinations the students are advised to observe the following:

- \* Must make a Note of correct timings of the examinations and attend accordingly.
- \* Should bring the admission tickets to the hall every day. They should read the instructions given in the admission tickets and act accordingly.
- \* Should not wear aprons.
- \* Should not carry mobiles, any electronic gadgets, chits, slips or any written matter into the hall.
- \* Students should not reveal their identity in any manner and only the registration number is to be written on the first page in the given box.
- \* Should not do any act, which may make them liable to be booked under malpractice.

### **During Practical Examinations**

- \* They should wear neat white aprons.
- \* Bring the admission tickets with them on each day of the examination.
- \* Bring the required instruments and other accessories.
- \* Bring the record books of work done which are duly certified by the head of the department.

The complete classification and the subject wise arrangement using Dewey decimal classification has been made.

### **General procedure/guidelines**

The Students should submit the details viz., Name, Course, Year, Department, Address for correspondence, e-mail, and a recent passport photograph, to Library Office for the purpose of library database and ID card generation.

- ★ ID card should be collected from the Admission Section only
- ★ The college ID card which acts as Library Card is Not Transferable.
- ★ Students should show ID card for reference and borrow library books

The undersigned is directed to refer to the above subject and please to bring to the notice of the Institutions / Students and other various stakeholders that ragging is criminal offence and Medical Council of India has framed regulations, on curbing the menace of ragging in Medical Colleges in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the source of ragging. The Regulations are called **Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges/ Institutions, Regulations, 2009**. The Regulations under reference have been notified in the Part II, Section 4 of the Gazette of India on 03.08.2009. These Regulations have already been circulated to all the Medical Colleges existing India vide this office circular No. 34(1)/2009-Med./31046, dated 21.08.2009 and are also available on the MCI website i.e. [www.mciindia.org](http://www.mciindia.org).

**What Constitutes Ragging?**  
Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of harassing, teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

**Punishable ingredients of Ragging:-**

- Abetment to ragging
- Criminal conspiracy to rag
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- Public nuisance created during ragging
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- Wrongful restraint
- Wrongful confinement
- Use of criminal force
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences
- Extortion, Criminal trespass, Criminal intimidation
- Offences against property
- Physical or psychological humiliation.
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s)
- All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging".

**Awardable Punishments**

8.1 At the Medical College / Institution level : Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

8.1.1 Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.

8.1.2 Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.

8.1.3 Debarment from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation Process.

8.1.4 Withholding results.

8.1.5 Debarment from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.

8.1.6 Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.


8.1.7 Cancellation of admission.


8.1.8 Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters.


8.1.9 Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarment from admission to any other institution for a specific period.


8.1.10 Fine of Rs. 25,000/- and Rs. 1 lakh.

8.1.11 Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are Not identified, the institution shall resort to collective Punishment.

## **Ragging**

### **What Constitutes Ragging?**

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written by an act which has the effect of harassing, teasing or handling with rudeness any other students indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of scheme or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psycho of a fresher or a junior student

### **Punishable ingredients of ragging**

- ♦ Abetment to ragging
- ♦ Criminal conspiracy to rag
- ♦ Unlawful assembly and rioting which ragging
- ♦ Public nuisance created during ragging
- ♦ Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- ♦ Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- ♦ Wrongful restraint
- ♦ Wrongful confinement
- ♦ Use of criminal force
- ♦ Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences □ Extortion
- ♦ Criminal trespass
- ♦ Offences against property
- ♦ Criminal intimidation
- ♦ Attempts to commit any or all the above mentioned offences against the victim
- ♦ Physical or psychological humiliation
- ♦ All other offences following from the definition of ragging

### **Awardable punishments**

- ♦ At the Medical College/Institution level : depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the antiragging committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following
- ♦ Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- ♦ Withholding /with-drawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits



- ◆ Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process withholding results
- ◆ Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process withholding results
- ◆ Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.,
- ◆ Suspension/expulsion from the hostel/ cancellation of admission
- ◆ Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- ◆ Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for specific period
- ◆ Fine of Rs. 25000/- and Rs. 1.00 lakh
- ◆ Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

The committee would work to ensure support and integrate international students in various events of the institution.

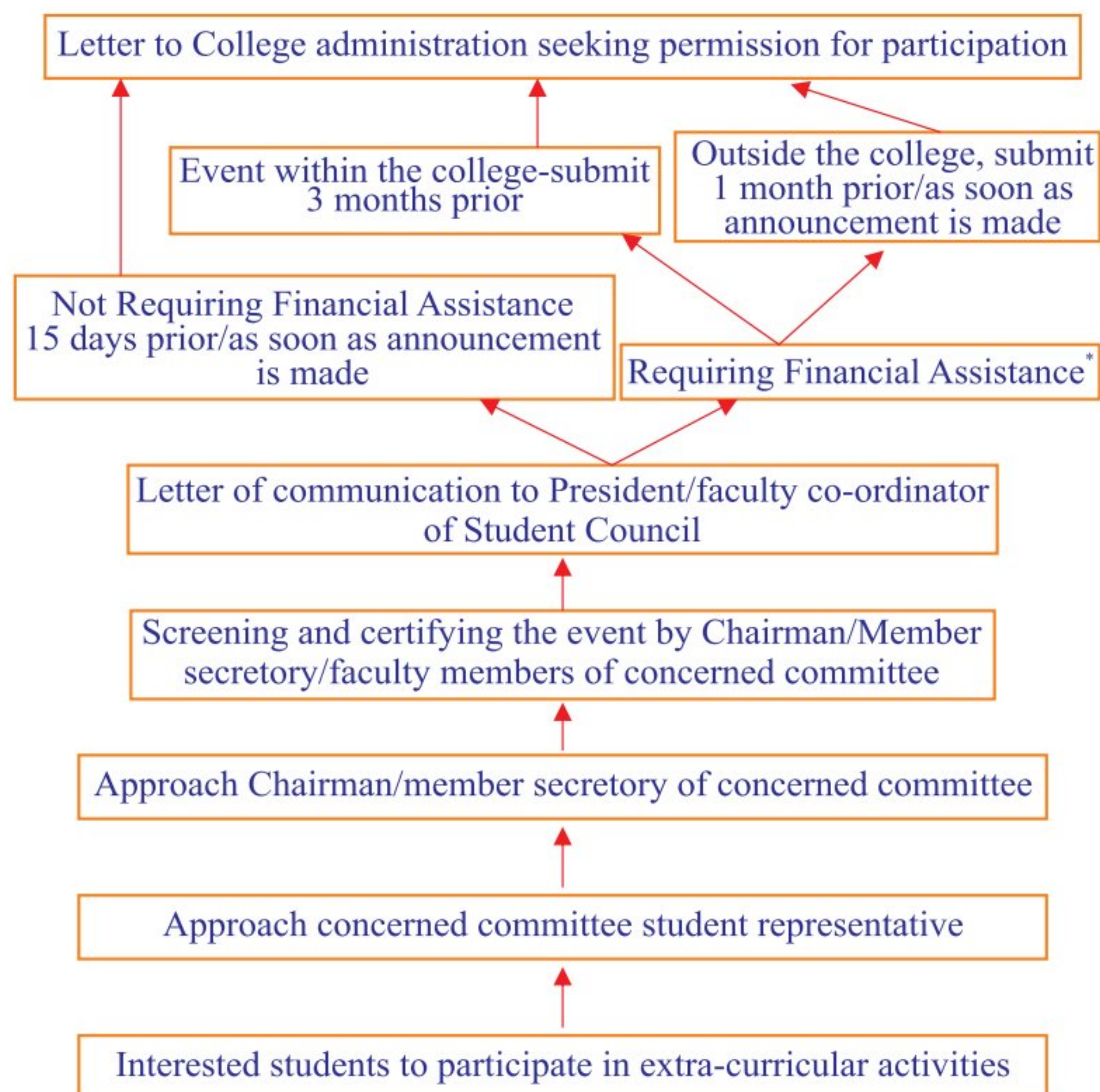
### Standard Operating Procedure: The Committee shall,
