Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.JSS/DC/Acad-1/18/2003-2004, dated 12.8.2003 accepting the conditions of Letter of Intent issued by this Ministry on 5.8.2003 and to convey the formal permission of the Central Government under section 10A(4) of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 for increasing the seats in MDS Course in the specialities of (i) Orthodontics from 2 to 3; (ii) Pedodontia from 2 to 3; (iii) Oral & Maxillo-facial Surgery from 2 to 3; (iv) Prosthodontics from 2 to 5; (v) Conservative Dentistry from 2 to 3; and (vi) Periodontics from 2 to 3 at J.S.S Dental College & Hospital, Mysore, Karnataka from the academic session 2003-04.

2. This permission is granted for a period of one year i.e. for admitting one batch with enhanced capacity only for the academic session 2003-04 and will be renewed on yearly basis after verification of the achievements of the annual targets.

3. The admission with enhanced capacity for 2nd batch i.e. for 2004-05 will be made only after renewal of permission by the central Government. In case any admissions are made in violation of this condition, such admissions would be treated as irregular and action under Section 10B of the Act would be initiated.

The Secretary, Dental Council of India, Kotla Road, New Delhi -2, alongwith the original Bank Guarantee of Rs. 40 Lakhs issued by Global Trust Bank, valid upto 11.8.2006 with a request to verify the genuineness of the same from the concerned Bank Authorities. It is also requested to arrange for inspection of the institute and send the recommendation for renewal of permission for 2nd year by 28th February 2004 positively. In case, it is found that the college has not been able to create the necessary infrastructure for 2nd year with increased capacity as per DCI Regulations, necessary immediate steps may be taken to stop their admissions for 2nd batch 2004-05 with increased capacity.
