



END OF YEAR REPORT

The JSS Medical College Quiz Club, Labyrinth, remains to be a vibrant space for analytical minds driven by curiosity, critical thinking and a shared love for trivia. This club, which started out as a group of passionate quizzers, has evolved into a platform that fosters both cooperative learning and competitive excellence. Throughout the academic year Labyrinth saw active engagement from all batches and thanks to its intercollegiate representations, made its presence known both on and off campus.

Labyrinth organized F.Y.I. (For Your Information), the First Year Invitational Quiz, a general quiz held on 11th December, 2024. Participants from all batches came together for the event, creating a fun and competitive environment for both novice and seasoned quizzers. Karan Mody, Sagar Shaji, and Mohammed Adnan Ibrahim (3rd year) emerged as winners, while Saket P. Rao and Hargun Loomba (1st year) secured second place.

The Offline Interactive Quiz that's one of our main on-campus highlights, was held on 19th May 2025 witnessed enthusiastic participation from 18 teams, representing all MBBS batches. The quiz featured a dynamic blend of general knowledge, current affairs, and pop culture. After an intense and closely fought quiz, Sagar Shaji, Malavika Vidhugopan, and Karan Mody bagged first place. The runners up were Ahana, Aanya and Akanksha who demonstrated remarkable depth of knowledge and presence of mind.



Labyrinth also made its mark on the national intercollegiate stage at Silhouettes 2025, the annual cultural fest of AFMC, Pune. Dr. Arush Sudan and Dr. Abhijit C clinched the first position at The Sports Quiz and the Mythology and History Quiz conducted on 8th May 2025. The team also secured second position in the fandom quiz.

The club extended its outreach by taking part in Shabd 2025 which is the annual literary fest of JSS Science and Technology University, Mysuru. A Pop Culture Trivia Quiz was conducted on 22nd June 2025, attracting over 30 teams. Spanning multiple rounds and genres ranging from music, films to comics, internet culture, and more. Representing JSSMC, Dr. Arush Sudan (Intern), Dr. Krishna Rajmohan (Intern), and Ankit Agarwal (3rd Year) secured second place.

During Tatvam 2025, our annual cultural fest, the club organised The General Quiz, which witnessed participation from 35 teams. This highly engaging and intellectually rigorous session was conducted by renowned quizmaster Berty Ashley. The team of Dr. Dhrish, Ahana, and Navya clinched the first position, followed by Dr. Yashvardhan, Dr. Arush and Dr. Krishna in second place, while Ghaanavi, Dhriti and Varsha secured the third position.

Our other event called the MELA quiz, blended iconic moments with niche artistic insights. While 37 teams participated, only a few made it to the top. Dr. Arush and Dr. Yashvardhan secured the first place, followed by Karan and Adnan in second and Sowmika and Chethna in third.



During the intercollegiate fest Spandan held at JIPMER, members of Labyrinth—Arush, Krishna, Yashvardhan, Dhrish and Harikrishnan—participated across multiple quiz events and delivered strong performances. The team secured first- and third-place finishes in the Fandom Quiz, first place in the Rewind Quiz, and second-place finishes in the Sports Quiz and the India Quiz. These results reflected consistent competitive excellence and reinforced Labyrinth’s presence on the intercollegiate quizzing circuit.

Labyrinth ensured sustained member engagement by actively leveraging social media platforms and WhatsApp based initiatives. Regularly posted questions, themed quizzes, and interactive prompts encouraged participation beyond formal events, allowing members to engage at their convenience.
