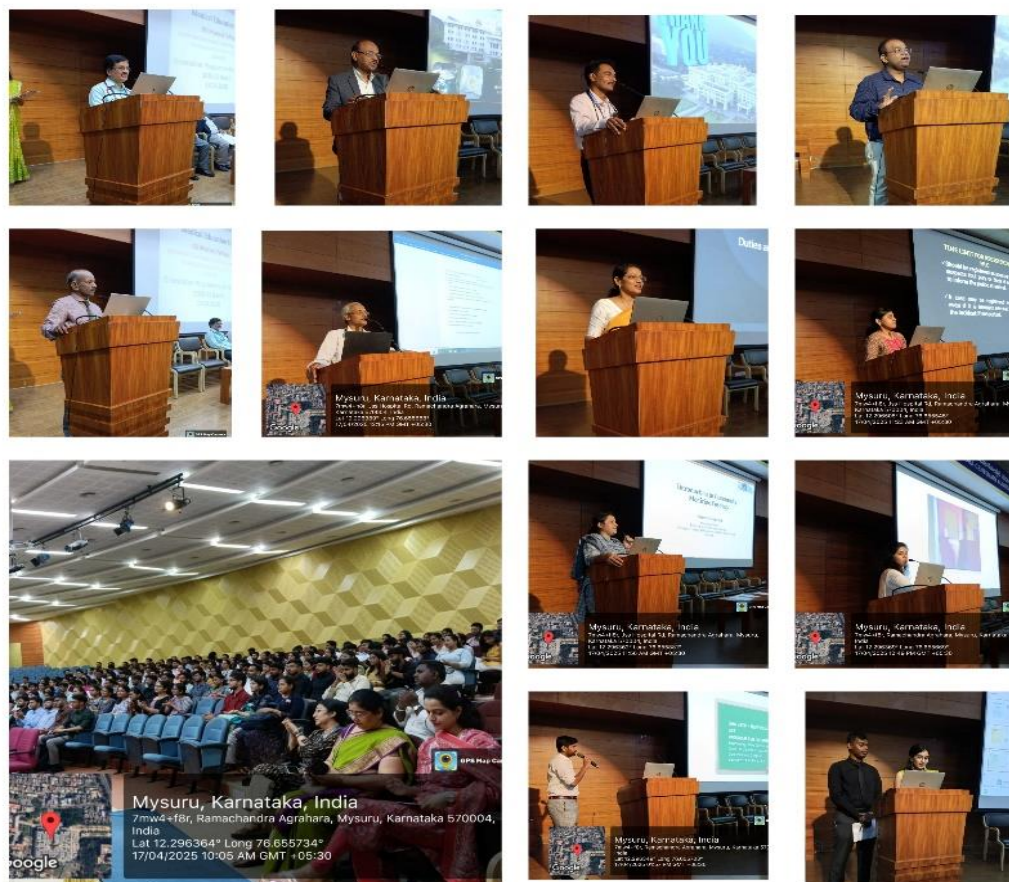

Essential clinical skills workshop for Interns

As a part of interns orientation program for Interns, hands on training workshop on essential clinical skills was organized @ JSSAHER skill & simulation center on 21st & 22nd April 2025. Total 179 students attended the workshop in two batches.

- One hour of interactive lecture session was on blood transfusion and procedure & protocol to be followed in the blood bank. Session was taken by Dr. Pallavi H R Professor transfusion medicine.
- Next session was on Basic interpretation of ECG. Session was taken by Dr. Nandhini & Dr. Radha, Dept. of General Medicine.

Following 2 interactive lectures, students were divided into 4 groups for hands on training.

- Station 1: Basic Airway Management and respiratory arrest taken by department of Anaesthesia.
- Station 2: Basics of non-invasive ventilation and Invasive ventilatory modes taken by dept of Critical Care Medicine Dr. Pooja & Dr. Sahana were resource faculty.
- Station 3: Handling emergencies and having good communication skills taken by dept of Simulation Centre, Dr. Archana S and Dr. Sarika M Shetty
- Station 4: Basics of fracture, POP application splint and bandaging taken by dept of Orthopaedics, Dr. Vijay, Dr. Puneeth, Dr. Madhukesh were the resource Faculty from Dept of orthopaedics.
