Minutes


1. Dr. M. Ramesh, Member Secretary welcomed all the members of the committee.
2. Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and confirmed.
3. Dr. M. Ramesh briefed the committee members on action taken report of the previous meeting.
4. Committee members were briefed on five guest lectures related to patient safety delivered by the staff of Department of Clinical Pharmacy during the period of April – June 2022.
5. Member Secretary briefed the committee members on webinar on ‘Vaccine Safety Monitoring & Research’ held on 28th May 2022.
6. Pharmacovigilance activities (ADRs, AEFI, Medication Incidents, Medical Device Related Adverse Events and Transfusion Related Reactions) for the period 1st April - 30th June 2022 were presented and discussed.

 - e. Provide metrics on nursing staff workload and inpatient admission.
